The gates of Hell shall not prevail against the Church (Mt 16:18), which is the culmination of the promise to Abram (Gen 12:3). We know we belong to Jesus because of the Spirit (1 Jn 4:13). We are given now, by promise, everything we need (2 Pet 1:3-4).
Isaac goes out to meet Rebekah (Gen 24:63-65).	Jesus will descend from Heaven and meet us in the air (1 Thess 4:16 -17).
Rebekah, belonging to Isaac but having never seen him, becomes one flesh with Him (Gen 24:67).	We are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is (1 Jn 3:2).
