When Jesus Singles You Out - The Scribe

Not everything Jesus did and said has been recorded for us. "Now there are also many other things that Jesus did. Were every one of them to be written, I suppose that the world itself could not contain the books that would be written" (Jn 21-25, ESV). So when Biblical authors make an effort to record a distinct comment Jesus made about an individual, it is worth our attention. Why did Jesus single them out?

Jesus said of a scribe in Mark 12:34, "You are not far from the kingdom of God." Please understand the weight of this statement. When Jesus says this we ought to very well know what He is talking about! The scribe had previously asked Jesus which is the most important commandment. When Jesus gave the answer, the scribe agreed saying, "To love Him...and to love one's neighbor...is much more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices." It was to this rationale that Jesus said, "You are not far from the kingdom of God." This is not to disparage the Law of Moses. Jesus is saying that love is greater than method or ritual. The heart is "much more" important than the mechanics. When we believe this, Jesus can say of us, "You are not far from the kingdom of God."
