What Is Easter?

The short answer is that Easter is an approximate annual anniversary of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Easter falls on the first Sunday after the first full moon of Spring. This dating seemed to originate as an attempt to use the Western solar calendar to coincide with the Jewish Passover (Christ's resurrection historically occurred around Passover). Determining precise dates of ancient historical events is tricky business. It gets even more tricky when you are converting from a Jewish lunar calendar to a solar Gregorian calendar. The importance isn't in the date – it's remembering that this time of year is when our Lord rose from the dead. – Cooper Atkeson
