God is omniscient (all-knowing). God knows all facts (Mt 10:30). He knows everything about entire branches of knowledge that we don't even know exist! God knows all events – past, present, and future (Is 42:9). He fully comprehends all of space-time even before it has “happened.” God understands all people. He can judge people because he knows their heart (1 Sam 16:7). God knows all possible realities – what would have happened if any person, including himself, made different choices (Mt 11:23). To the extent that God has revealed himself, we can understand some of God's reasoning and actions (Rom 12:2). However, we cannot understand everything about his actions as, by definition, he knows more than us. Read Job 38:1-18 to see the contrast between God's knowledge and ours described.
