What Is Meditation?

The first Psalm says that a blessed man meditates on the teachings of the LORD, day and night (1:2). What does it mean to meditate? This translated Hebrew word, literally meaning something like "growl," "moan," or "mutter," seems to indicate some process by which the words were mentally and, likely, verbally repeated. This would facilitate learning for both the mind and the heart - the mind learns by rote and the heart is penetrated by truth by consistent exposure. We may be more familiar with study, which is the inquiry and pursuit of truth. Meditation is that which takes place after truth has been discovered.
