Words For Worship

Three different Greek verbs are translated "worship" in our Bibles: *proskuneo*, *latreuo*, and *sebo*.

Latreuo (and its noun equivalent) is usually translated "service" but is sometimes rendered "worship." This is because it references service of a religious nature like that of a priest. Originating from the Greek word meaning "hired servant," this word connotes a service of intentional or special designation. You can find examples of *latreuo* in Rom 12:1 and Phil 3:3.

"I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual **worship**."
