Words For Worship

Three different Greek verbs are translated "worship" in our Bibles: *proskuneo*, *latreuo*, and *sebo*.

Proskuneo (and its noun equivalent) is the word in the New Testament most often translated as "worship." It means to express in attitude or gesture one's complete dependence on, or submission to, a high authority figure. Containing the Greek word meaning "to kiss," proskuneo was frequently used to designate the custom of prostrating oneself before persons and kissing their feet, their garment, or the ground. You can find examples of proskuneo in Luke 4:7-8 and John 4:20-23.
