Barbara Dodd is scheduled for a procedure on October 13. Pray for comfort, and that the procedure will be successful.

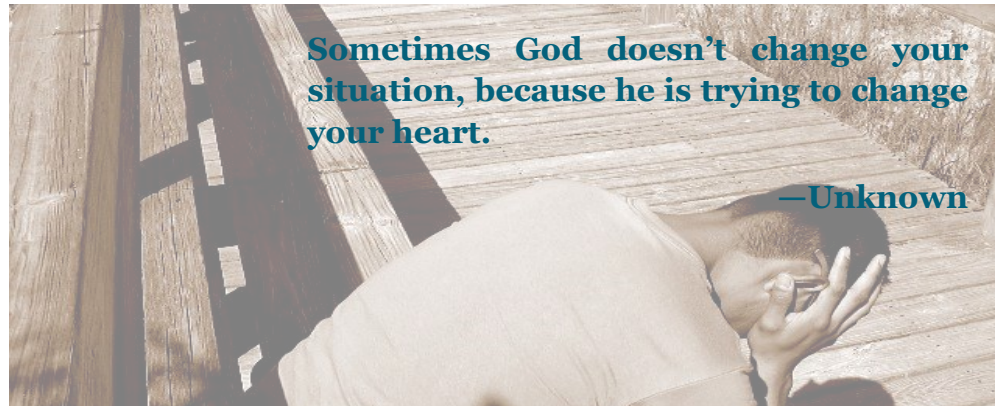
Kathy Coleman had surgery for a detached retina this week. Please pray for patience and comfort as she has a difficult two-week recovery.
