

Jean Bolton is still trying to regain her health and strength. Please lift up Jean and Bob in your prayers.

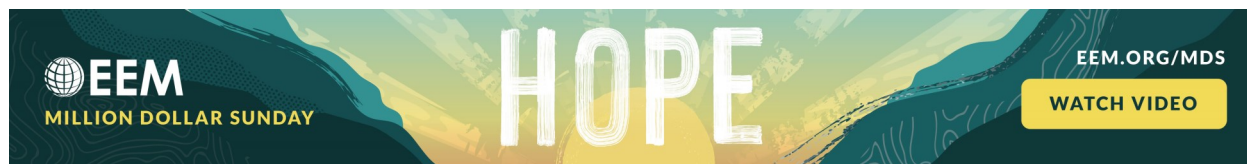
