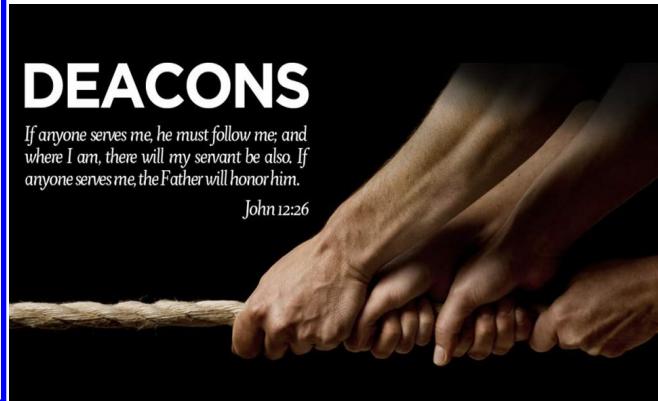
### Ministry and Activity
