We will have a **5th Sunday Potluck** on July 30th, after the morning worship service. The main course will be provided. More details will follow.

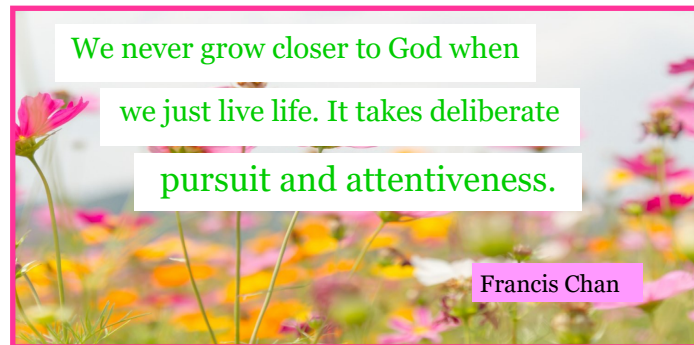
