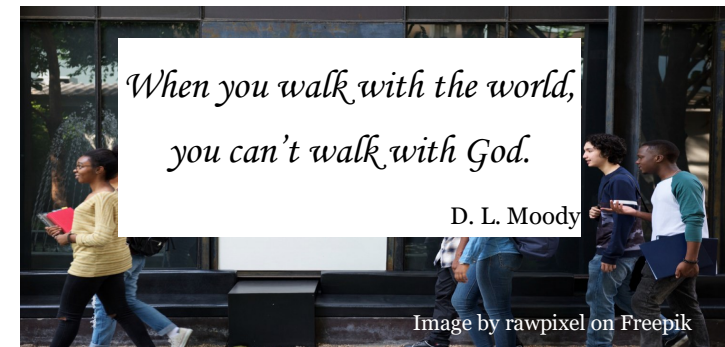
Vickie Shawver is requesting prayers for her sister, Rosie Rodriguez Garcia. She is experiencing various health difficulties.
