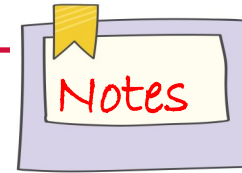
Sermon Scripture

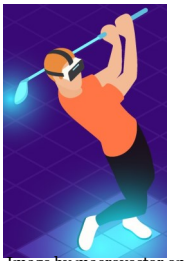
